3 Big Ideas: READING

Fluency: Children read any text competently silently and aloud with intonation and expression.

Comprehension: Children recall, deduce and infer information from wide ranging texts, understanding contextual vocabulary.

Pleasure: Children love growing their imaginations and creative thinking, reading for knowledge growth and pleasure throughout their lives.

3 Big Ideas: WRITING

Composition: Children plan, draft, edit and publish increasingly progressed pieces of writing with accurate grammatical structures, extending description and use of language.

Communication: Children use a growing range of adventurous vocabulary and language structures to express themselves.

Ambition: Children are inspired to write for impact and effect.
