Three Big Ideas:

Faith: Children explore and describe their own and others' beliefs

Understanding: Children learn key concepts underpinning different religions and religious practices. They explore religious stories and recognise their meaning. They appreciate how individuals and cultures are shaped and influenced by religion.







Acceptance: Children understand and respect the views and beliefs of others.
